



## The Lark Adventist Church

The Lark Seventh-day Adventist Church had its beginnings in the period between 1916 and 1920.

Mr. and Mrs. David McClelland homesteaded in what was then Morton County but was later divided and his section became Grant County.

The McClellands were Bible workers and had been missionaries in England. Due to her poor health she was forced to take a leave of absence.

They homesteaded and built up a farm twenty miles south of Almont, North Dakota. While there were on this place they held meetings in a rural school house.

Mrs. Rupert, the widow of a Dunkard minister, her two sons Wilbur and Adam and their wives, attended these meetings and were baptized and joined the church. The mother of the two Ruperts' wives was also an Adventist that had come from Sioux City, Iowa.

Adam Rupert sold his farm and went to Sheyenne River Academy and on to college and entered the ministry.

McClellands left their farm around 1920 to reenter the work for the Lord.

In about 1928 a neighbor, Fred Nichols, who was an invalid, invited the Lark church to have Sabbath School in his home. He said he thought we had the truth as we had met without having any trouble in our church as other Protestant groups did.

There were several short efforts held through the years and in 1930, Pastor Harry Wentland held meetings in a school house. As a result of these meetings fourteen were baptized.

In 1930, Mr. Nichols deeded an acre of land and a church was built by the members. There was a membership of 28 at that time. The families were: Bruingtons, Browns, Days, Ruperts, Nichols and Nogles.

With the national depression and the drought most of the church members left the state, some to Minnesota and some to the west coast.

Pastors through the years were Harry Wentland, I. C. Schmidt and Ranken Wentland.

In 1937, at the insistence of Elder Wall, the church was sold to the Presbyterians and moved to Carson. Most of the remaining members joined the Bismarck church or the Burt church, later to be known as the New Leipzig church.

NOTE: The town of Lake, North Dakota is located off of Highway 21 between Flasher and Carson. According to ND Home Town Locator, Lark currently has a population of 45 with a negative growth rate.

Note: Due to the significant cost of this test, reward points are suspended for the time being (except for apheresis donors, who give specific blood components via special equipment).


