

# **Are You Hearing Voices?**

Some would say that anyone who hears strange voices should see a doctor, but I'm not sure a medical doctor will help in this instance. You see, the voices I am personally hearing are coming from within the Seventh-day Church, some of the same voices that split early Adventism into different directions and different denominations over 150 years ago.



The voices are saying, "Jesus and the Holy Spirit are not fully equal with the Father in every way." My first thought is the old Devil has not given up, but is in fact doubling down on God's people in these last days. One could say Satan has pulled another chapter out of the Garden of Eden Playbook by casting doubt. He must laugh when he hears members of the church make statements like, "Yes, Jesus is God, just not at the level of God the Father." And yes, one of the newest voices is the false theory that God the Father holds headship over God the Son, and God the Son over the Holy Spirit. The belief in Headship within the Godhead is like saying we have one major God and two lesser or subordinate gods. The 28 Fundamental Beliefs of the Adventist Church is rock solid - the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are equal, a unity of three co-eternal Persons.

I first heard these voices in differing degrees out of an independent ministry in California a few short years ago and then more recently supported by other independent ministries. Philippians 2:6, speaking of Jesus, says, "Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: 7 But made Himself of no reputation, and took upon Him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men." This text speaks to the equality of Jesus with the Father. It deeply concerns me when we try and break apart the work of the Godhead and separate Their work in lines of authority.

In closing I share a thought from Pastor Bower of the Bismarck Church. "I think the only thing we could safely say about headship within the Godhead is that when Jesus was incarnate here on earth He submitted Himself to the Father and took on a subservient role. After the ascension, however, He was elevated back to the throne and all authority was given to Him. When Jesus says, 'all authority in heaven and on earth' was given to Him, that seems pretty all encompassing."

### **DAKOTA ADVENTIST ACADEMY**

Dakota Adventist Academy is blessed to have strong financial support from the Dakota Conference, constituency and alumni. As you make your gift, please consider one of the following areas to support.

**Annual Fund** are unrestricted donations that are valuable to the operation of the school. They contribute to the stability and security of the school program and are applied where the need is greatest. **Our annual goal is \$275,000.** 

Worthy Student Fund donations go to work immediately in assisting students with financial needs. The number of students requiring assistance varies from year to year, however, we plan for at least 50% of our student body needing financial assistance. Our annual goal is \$125,000.

**Dorm Renovation** - Hundreds of students have passed through these halls since the school was opened in 1977. Each of our dorms now has one complete hall renovated. The cost of renovating a room is \$5,232 which includes upgrading the bathrooms between the rooms. A **goal of \$80,000 each year** would renovate one wing.

PVA - Ron Purkapile South Dakota Student Scholarship Fund provides scholarship grants for the benefit of students whose home church is located in South Dakota and is part of the Dakota Conference, and who are enrolled in and attending Dakota Adventist Academy. Donations to the scholarship fund should be made out to Dakota Conference Corporation and marked for the PVA-Ron Purkapile Scholarship Fund.

**Gifts-in-kind** are gifts of a non-monetary nature that will benefit the school. They enrich programs and capital improvement. Examples would be furniture, landscape materials, library books or musical instruments.

Planned Gifts benefit DAA through your estate plan. As you determine how your estate will be handled after your death, you can plan to give a portion to DAA. Since 2012, DAA has received over \$92,000 in estate gifts. These gifts have tax implications



and are often transmitted through a legal document such as a Will or Trust. We encourage you to talk with your financial planner, CPA or attorney to determine what form of planned gift will work best for you and your family.

**Special Funds -** Donors may give to a variety of programs including music, mission trips, art, basketball, volleyball and Acrolights. These also enrich the quality of the programs offered to the students.

Endowed Funds "Touch the Future for Youth, Today" focuses on building financial stability that will benefit students in the future. These funds, held at the Dakota Conference, are permanent funds that provide lasting financial resources for DAA. Invested in interest-earning accounts, the income is used annually for the designated purpose the endowment (capital of improvement, worthy student, operating expenses, etc.). Donations for endowment should be made out to Dakota Conference Corporation and sent to Dakota Conference marked for endowment.
