Dr. Cedric Vine is an associate professor of New Testament at Andrews University. Before coming to Andrews, he taught in the Department of Theological Studies at Newbold College.

He has also served as a pastor in the north of England for nine years. In 2012, he defended his doctoral thesis at the University of Sheffield, UK, on the question of the audience of Matthew's Gospel.
