
Pastor Cheri states, "Life is full and blessed as we lean on the ONE that makes all things work together for good!"

Hike to Petrified Forest with Tami Flemmer:

Park Fee Must be Paid on Own

The trail travels up out of the badlands onto a wide prairie where it splits, each section then dropping down into a valley containing the petrified stumps. Both sections of petrified wood are approximately 1.5 miles from the parking area.

<u>Local Attractions</u>: Come to Medora early and visit some local attractions!

Theodore Roosevelt National Park: The South Unit Visitor Center is located in Medora. Drive through the beautiful national park. Visitor fees are \$30/vehicle.

Cowboy Hall of Fame: \$9/adults, \$7/seniors

Chateau de Mores: \$10
